Launched by the Government of Nova Scotia in April 2023, the Nova Scotia Clean Electricity Solutions Task Force has been consulting with customers of Nova Scotia Power, environmental advocates and others about ensuring Nova Scotia's electricity system is ready for a net zero future.

Indigenous specific engagement is also being pursued.

A final report is due to the Nova Scotia government in early 2024.

The deadline for submissions is October 15, 2023.

Nova Scotians are asked to focus on the key questions that have been assigned to the Task Force:

What is the state of our electricity infrastructure in terms of reliability, capacity and storage to meet Nova Scotia's climate change goals and what changes should be made?

Is our utility infrastructure that is shared with essential services such as telecommunications adequate and what can reasonably be done under provincial jurisdiction to ensure its adequacy?

What measures should be taken to support the ability of Nova Scotians to afford the price of electricity as we undertake an energy transition resulting from climate change and other factors?

Are there changes to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board Act that should be made in terms of electricity, transmission and rates?
